MEMBERSHIP TYPES

Active Full Home Club Member:

This membership category is designed for skaters that want to take full advantage of the sport of figure skating. If you are taking private lessons on a regular basis, this membership is for you. This category of membership includes the following:

- USFSA membership for one skater 18 years or older (additional USFSA membership for a named adult of a skater under the age of 18)
- Voting rights and ability to hold a board position for a member 18 years of age or older.
- Testing privileges
- Ability to compete under the club name outside of Jacksonville Ice
- One subscription to Skating magazine
- Discounts on stickers for freestyle ice
- Discount on all club sponsored clinics
- All other benefits listed in other memberships

Cost: \$135 annually (additional family members can be added at a cost of \$25 each)

Active Coaches Member:

This membership category is designed for coaches, 18 years and older, who work with the Learn to skate program, as well as those who conduct private lessons in accordance with the rink. This category of membership includes the following:

- USFSA membership
- Voting rights and ability to hold a board position for a member 18 years of age or older.
- Testing privileges
- Coaching rights on Club Ice.
- One subscription to *Skating* magazine
- 10% discount in the pro-shop

Cost: \$85 annually

Associate Member:

This membership category is designed for skaters who are full members in good standing, in another club, but who frequently use our rink for coaching or other reasons. This category of membership includes the following:

- Club Ice privileges (Fees apply)
- Discounts on stickers for freestyle ice
- All other benefits listed below

Cost: \$60 annually

Introductory Member:

This membership category is designed for skaters who are enrolled in the Basic Skills, Learn to Skate, Program. This is an introductory membership designed for the family new to figure skating. This category of membership includes two named adults and up to two named skaters (or three named skaters if only one adult member is indicated). ***If you are not enrolled in the basic skills program, you are not eligible for this type of membership. Because this is for new skating families, this membership category is only available for one year. This membership is not eligible for test privileges or to compete under the club name, outside of Jacksonville Ice.*** This category of membership includes the following:

- Club Ice privileges (Fees apply)
- 10% discount on all rink sponsored classes/clinics/shows
- 10% discount in the pro-shop
- One free ticket to any show you are enrolled in
- Various club discounts.

Cost: \$50 annually (each additional member above the two named adults and two named children is \$10 each)

SKATER’S CODE OF CONDUCT

Maintaining a positive atmosphere on the ice and in the arena is essential in developing a successful experience for the skater.

“During skating, I will be an example to others through my speech, conduct, and training. I will be responsible for my actions as I represent my Club and Rink.”

In addition skater will:

1. Treat every skater with respect
2. Treat all coaches with respect.
3. Follow proper procedures on the ice, including maintaining a proper distance from those working on the ice, and giving the right away to those in lessons, or running their programs with music.
4. Adhere to all rink and Club policies.
5. Encourage one another.
6. Be totally involved and have a positive attitude during practice and competitions.
7. Have a high regard for one and other and treat each other’s equipment as your own, including Club and Rink equipment, such as CD players.
8. Promote and participate in Club and Rink activities.
9. Do not physically or verbally harm other skaters.

PARENT’S CODE OF CONDUCT

The participation of all parents is essential to provide a positive experience for the skaters and coaches. Our support is valued and your assistance is greatly appreciated.

It is essential that parents:

1. Are positive in constructive criticism of programs, coaches, and skaters. Please present any opinions or criticism in writing to those in charge.
2. Refrain from unsportsmanlike conduct. Unsportsmanlike conduct is defined as any verbal or non-verbal action, which diminishes the fun and enjoyment of skaters or spectators.
3. Recognize that skaters are children and not professionals. The need encouragement not criticism.
4. Applaud a good skating performance, ignore errors, and encourage a greater effort, initiative and dedication. Always congratulate achievement and encourage improvement – No one is a loser!!
5. If you have concerns regarding your child’s caching to his/her coach in private and not on the ice.
